<b>Outcome</b>	An awareness programme on Menstrual Hygiene and HIV/AIDS creates a lasting impact by promoting health education, breaking taboos, and encouraging safe practices. Girls and women become more aware of safe and hygienic practices during menstruation, reducing the risk of infections. Open discussions help break cultural taboos and silence around menstruation, making it easier for girls to seek help and support. Participants learn about how HIV is transmitted and how it can be prevented through safe practices like condom use and regular testing. Reduced stigma leads to better emotional and social support for people living with HIV.
